Shirley Chisholm has achieved many things during her lifetime. Write down these achievements in the purple circle. In the pink line below it, write down the qualities that you think helped her.

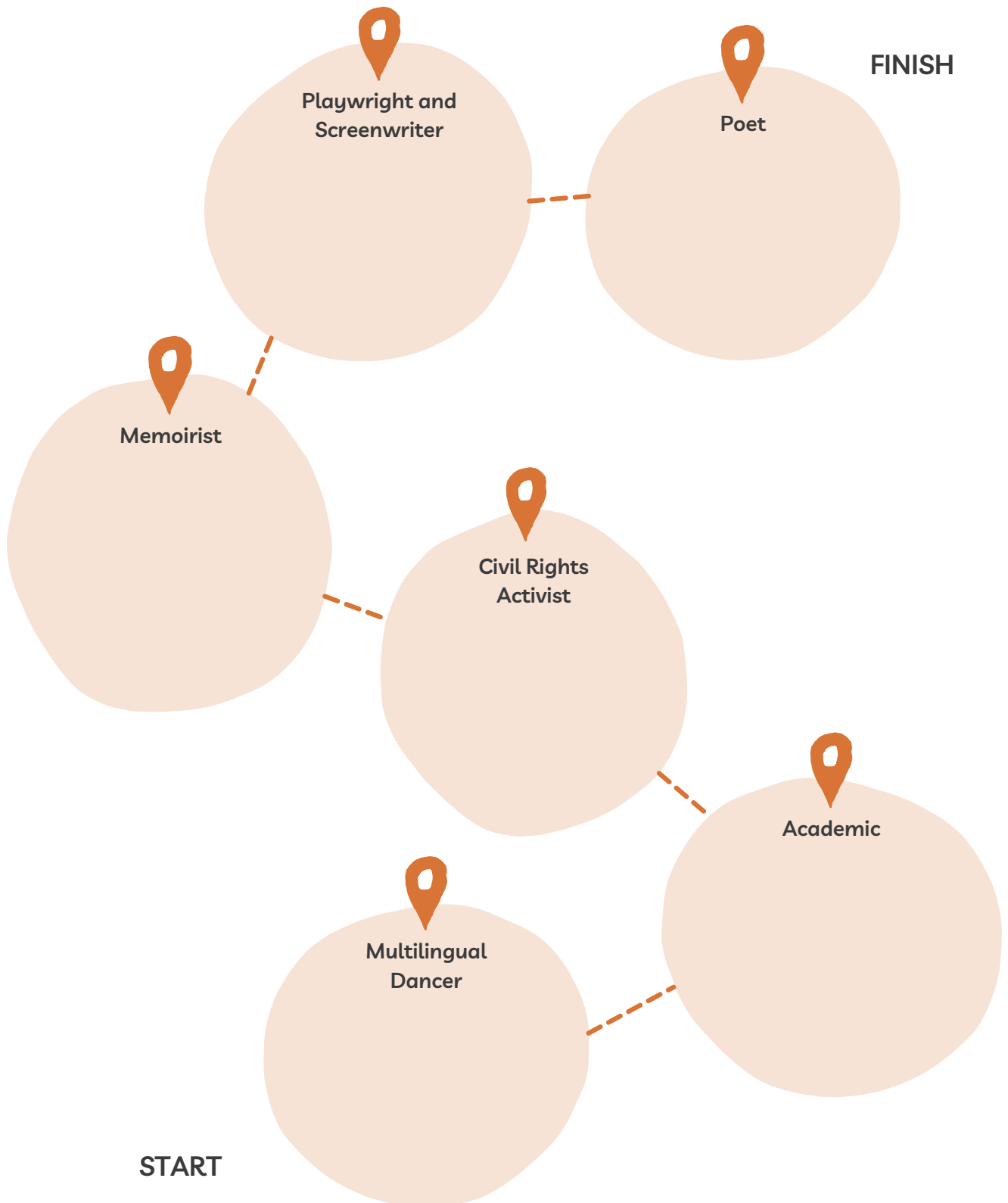
